

CALAMITY DAY PLAN:

The school may be closed and students are not required to attend school for a calamity day for any of the following reasons:

Hazardous weather conditions

- o Information on road conditions from transportation staff, law enforcement and road crews. The district gives careful consideration to the most dangerous roads in the district. They can be treacherous, even if your street looks clear.
- o Accumulated snow and ice.
- o Temperature and wind chill.
- o Impact on transportation services. School bus diesel fuel begins to gel at temperatures of zero degrees or below.
- o Weather predictions (including those from a weather alert service).
- o Building conditions (e.g., electricity, heat, water)

• Other conditions

- o Inoperability of school buses or equipment necessary to the school's operation.
- o Damage to a school building.
- o Temporary utility failure rendering the building unsuitable for school use.
